




#### Ferguson-Florissant School with Chess Clubs

- There were 18 Chess Clubs in Ferguson-Florissant schools in Fall 2015
  - O Average Free/Reduced Lunch in these schools = 78.5%
  - O Average percent minority in these schools = 88.4%

#### Pilot Survey Overview

- Pre and post surveys administered at the beginning and end of afterschool chess clubs in Ferguson-Florissant in Fall 2015
- Purpose:
  - Measure demographic characteristics of students
  - Measure if the Chess Clubs are increasing interest in chess and confidence in chess-playing ability
  - Measure if Chess Clubs increase students' confidence to take on difficult tasks and challenge themselves.


## Demographics: Ferguson-Florissant Clubs

Student Characteristics	
Percent female	37.9%
Percent Hispanic	3.9%
Percent white	12.9%
Percent Black	66.5%
Percent other ethnicity	17.2%
Average grade level	5.2
Number of pre-surveys	155
Number of post-surveys	92
Matched surveys (pre & post)	72

### **Summary of Findings**


- Nearly half of all students report that they had never played chess. A third had only played a few times.
- Pre-Post surveys find that participation in Chess Club:
  - Significantly increases playing chess with family & friends
  - Significantly increases confidence in chess-playing abilities
  - Increases plans to sustain chess-playing into adulthood
- Post surveys find:
  - 85% of students look forward to school more on days when they have Chess Club
  - o 91% of students report they would recommend Chess Club to a friend
  - More than 90% of students report that their experience in Chess Club will motivate them to take on difficult tasks and challenge themselves more in the future




# Have you ever played chess with a member of your family?




## Have you ever played chess with a friend outside of school?




### Chess is something I am good at.




### I am confident in my ability to play chess.




## I find chess confusing.




### I will play chess when I am an adult.




# I look forward to school more on days when I have Chess Club.




#### I would tell my friends they should join Chess Club.




# Being in Chess Club has taught me that I can complete difficult tasks if I work hard.
